We are inviting expressions of interest from urban Indigenous Peoples in BC who wish to join an Urban Indigenous Research Advisory Circle. This Advisory Circle will guide the research project *Urban Indigenous Governance in Health Research: Pathways for Engagement, Data Sovereignty, and Knowledge Translation*

About the Project

- Three-year project that explores how research standards and governance models shape health research for urban Indigenous Peoples in BC, and how health research processes can better uphold Indigenous self-determination.
- Focuses on Indigenous ownership of data, meaningful engagement, and how research knowledge is shared.
- Guided by Indigenous ways of knowing and community-based research approaches.

About the Advisory Circle

- Shares knowledge and lived experience with the university research team to guide how the research is done.
- Welcoming a wide range of experiences, backgrounds, including: 2SLGBTQI+, persons with disabilities, Elders, youth, young adults, urban Indigenous leaders, and others with urban Indigenous living experience.

What the Work Involves

- Attending bi-monthly (every 2 months) meetings on Zoom, each up to 2 hours.
- Provide advice between meetings by phone and email.
- Offer ideas on how to support meaningful community engagement, respectful sharing of research knowledge, and Indigenous ownership of data.
- Help build and strengthen relationships between Indigenous communities, organizations, and the university research team.

Preferred Experience

You may be a good fit if you have:

- Experience or interest in community engagement, data sovereignty, and health research
- Previous involvement in committees, working groups, or advisory circles
- Ability to work collaboratively with large multi-disciplinary teams and community groups
- Experience working with Indigenous communities and/or Indigenous service organizations

We value lived experience and community knowledge as much as formal education or professional experience!

Meetings & Acknowledgement of Your Time

- Meetings will take place up to 6 times per year via Zoom. Each meeting will be up to 2 hours.
- Honoraria: \$100 per hour in recognition of your time and expertise, including time spent advising outside of meetings via email and phone.
